

DRESS CODE

Proper classroom etiquette and attire is essential to the education and training of a dancer. The following rules are universal and are followed by all major dance programs and professional companies. We ask that you apply them at Studio 82 as well. Proper dance attire must be worn at all times.

ALL DANCERS SHOULD ALWAYS BE CLASSROOM APPROPRIATE.

No short shorts, no skimpy tops or bras. No clothing with inappropriate language or graphics. Stick with dancewear, not streetwear, for all classes.

Students will be asked to change or sit should they come to class inappropriately dressed.

In Ballet, a bun IS REQUIRED at all times. All other classes, hair should not be an impediment.

Pre-School - Pink leotard, Pink tights, Pink ballet slippers.

Kinder Ballet - Black leotard, Pink tights, Pink ballet slippers.

Kinder Jazz - Black leotard, or any dance top, or tee. Dance shorts or leggings. Tan, laceless, jazz shoes.

Ballet - Black leotard, Pink ballet tights, Pink ballet slippers.

Jazz – Any color leotard, dance top, or appropriate tee. Dance shorts, jazz pants, or leggings. Tan, laceless jazz shoes, flexible athletic shoes, or dance paws. **Bare feet ONLY at the teacher's discretion.**

Lyrical and Contemporary - Any color leotard, dance top, or appropriate tee. Dance shorts, jazz pants, or leggings. Dance paws or bare feet.

HipHop – Comfortable athletic attire. Leggings, sweatpants, shorts, Tshirts, sweatshirts, tank tops. NO JEANS. NO SKIRTS. Clean, dry, street sneakers.

Tap – Comfortable dance attire. No pants that drag on the floor, and no jeans. **BLACK, OXFORD STYLE, TAP SHOES REQUIRED.**
